

Seminar programme

A two-day intensive seminar with stimulating lecture programme in Russian, 10.00–16.20 daily. Two parallel streams led by speakers direct from St Petersburg, Russia.

Russian language & linguistics:

Tatiana Piotrovskaya, Senior Lecturer, Department of English Philology and Language Culture Studies, Faculty of Philology, St Petersburg State University.

Russian literary & cultural scene:

Vadim Levental, writer (works include the Russian Booker Prize nominated novel *Masha Regina* 2012), literary critic, book editor and political commentator.

Four 70-minute lectures per day, including discussion: choose one of two options per session, moving from one stream to another throughout the day as you wish.

Aimed at teachers of Russian, translators, interpreters, final-year undergraduates and graduates of Russian, and all those with an advanced-level comprehension of spoken Russian and an interest in contemporary Russia.

Morning and afternoon tea / coffee and biscuits included. Bring your own lunch or use local cafes.
